

New network: First year PBL at AAU

Most AAU study programmes include one or more courses and other activities addressing PBL and students' learning and most of these activities are organised during the first year of study when students have just left secondary education and are finding their identities as university students. This means many AAU employees are therefore involved as teachers, facilitators and supervisors of PBL during the first year.

As a response to the increased focus on the PBL principles also highlighted in the new AAU Strategy, it seems timely and relevant to bring together teachers and researchers working with or with an interest in first year PBL at AAU. We therefore invite for a first meeting to initiate a AAU Network on first year PBL. The network welcomes experiences with first year PBL across the faculties to inspire and hopefully contribute towards even better teaching and learning activities. To get the network off the ground, the PBL Academy will ensure organisation and initial facilitation of activities.

The network can serve multiple purposes as for example:

- To collect and share experiences and resources on first year PBL pedagogy
- To collect and share best practices across study programmes and faculties
- To share research and engage in research projects on first year PBL
- To setup an inspiring network of teachers and researchers

Prior to the first meeting we will forward a more detailed programme to all participants.
